Environmental Policy

Signpac is committed to running an environmentally friendly business. We have identified the following areas that we can reduce our impact on the environment, and ways that this can be done.

Areas and causes of environmental impact:

Emissions to Air

- Air Conditioning

Waste Paper & Products

- Excess paper from printing
- Backing Paper peeled from vinyl
- Waste paper and cardboard from packaging received

Use of Water

- Car Washing
- Sign Cleaning

Petrol/ Transport

- Old Vehicles
- Petrol used for transport to Quotes, Installations & deliveries

Electricity

- Air Conditioning Power
- Lights and general electricity
- Tools requiring power

Signpac is taking action in the following areas to minimise our impact on the environment:

Emissions

- Use of Air conditioning only in the middle (hot) part of the day
- Ensure Air conditioning is switched off when all people have left the office/ factory

Target: 50% less power on air conditioning by End of 2012

Waste Paper and Products

- Working with Veolia Environmental Services to implement a recycling program
- Putting together a list of recyclable products from sign wastage from suppliers- In particular Graphic Art Mart and Sign Sheet Distributors
- Spending extra time to separate all recyclable materials from waste
- Recycle Uden Ink cartridges from Desk-top and Industrial-sized printers

Target: 75% of Waste to be recycled every year

Use of Water

- Signpac will use minimal water to wash cars and signs.
- We will use recycled water wherever possible

Target Water use minimal at all times

Petrol/ Transport

- Owner, Jay Thorogood uses public transport to and from work whenever possible.
- Combine quotes and installations on the same day in the same physical area to reduce use of petrol
- Research into low- emission or electric vehicles for next vehicle upgrades (due end of 2012)

Target: Use 50L of fuel (combined for both vehicles) by end of 2011)

Electricity

- Signpac uses Origin Energy Green Power in our business.
- Signpac will continue to seek reports and assurance from origin energy that it's power source is environmentally friendly.
